



## COMMERCIAL CONTAINER ENCLOSURE GUIDE

## **DIRECT ACCESS**




## **NON-DIRECT ACCESS**



Gate Opening – Not all containers have wheels, so the truck will need room to drive into the enclosure and dump your container. Gate openings should have a minimum of a 10 foot opening; and hinges on the \*outside\* of the wall.

**Gate Stops** – Please be sure to install gate stops to hold gates open when we dump the container!

**Depth of Enclosure** – Allow a minimum of 10 feet for a front load container, and a minimum of 16 feet for a rear load container.



Enclosure depth can be smaller for smaller containers! Consult your sales representative to determine what type of container and enclosure will best meet your company's needs.

**Truck Access** – Please leave 40 feet of unobstructed clearance in front of the enclosure to allow our truck direct access to your container!

**Spacing** – Leave room for employees to walk on each side of your dumpster. A side opening is also recommended so employees do not have to open the large entry door.

Building Material – Chain link is recommended for enclosures, because the hinges are adjustable as the ground settles. Consult your municipality for fencing and height requirements. There should be a 6-inch thick concrete pad inside the enclosure, and at least 8 feet in front of the enclosure opening. This helps to reduce damage to both the pavement and the trucks.
